Goals

This structured practical training program is intended to help you understand and meet the standards of practice for pharmacy as outlined in the *Framework of Professional Practice*. It describes the standards of practice in the following five areas:

- Role 1: Provide pharmaceutical care
- Role 2: Produce and distribute drug preparations and products
- Role 3: Contribute to the effective operation of the pharmacy
- Role 4: Maintain professional development and contribute to the professional development of others
- Role 5: Contribute to the effectiveness of the health care system

 - you must be registered with the College of Pharmacists of BC, and
 - you must have successfully met the English language proficiency standard.
- Submit your application form and fees to the College office.

Program management

- Once your application is accepted by the College, we will forward your information to the SPEP office.
- The SPEP office is responsible for organizing all aspects of the internship program. A full information package, including site/preceptor selection and approval, will be sent to you by the SPEP office.
- The SPEP office will inform the College when you have met your Structured Practical Training requirements.
